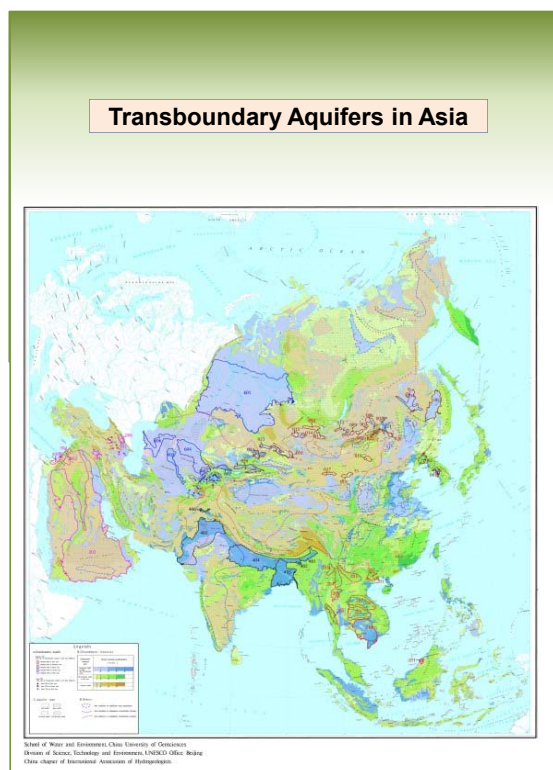
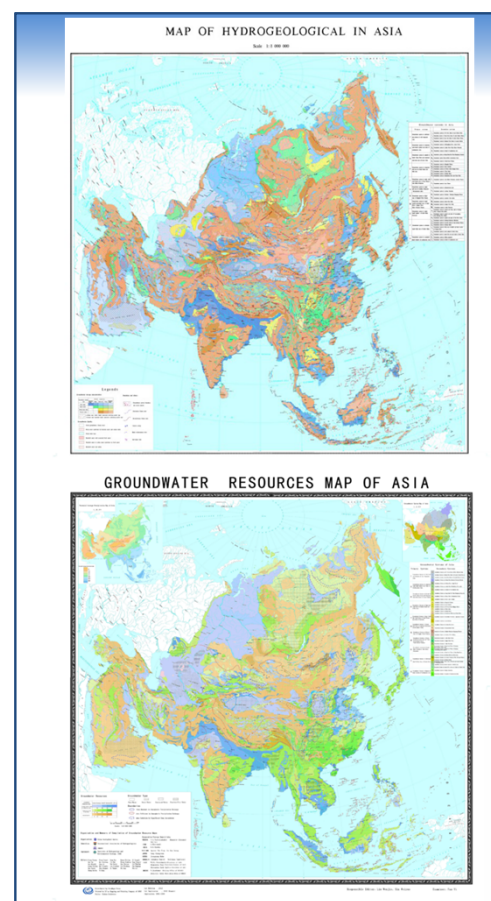


Groundwater resources and Transboundary Aquifers in Asia
